




#### **OVERDOSE EPIDEMIC**

- Over 300 fatal overdoses in San Francisco in 2018 (increase for a third year in a row)
- PWID are at a higher risk for communicable diseases like HIV & HCV.


#### PERCENTAGE OF NEW HIV INFECTIONS



## 1 in 5 new HIV infections in SF are among people experiencing homelessness


Less than a 1/3 of PLHIV experiencing homelessness are virally supressed (2017 SF HIV Epi Report)


#### PERCENTAGE OF HIV+ PEOPLE WHO ARE VIRALLY SUPPRESSED

AVERAGE VIRAL LOADS






