Housing is a human right, and we now that if you're worried about where you'll be sleeping you won't be able to take care of your health. Housing is fundamental to achieving justice for our communities.



- Housing subsidies for PLWHA

HIV

- California has higher HIV transmissions than any other state
- Nearly 12% don't know they're positive
- Black, brown, LGBT communities are hit hardest

02

VIRAL HEPATITIS

- Nearly half a million Californians are living with Hep C
- Half don't know
- Hep C is the deadliest communicable disease in the nation and it's curable

03

STIs

- In 2018 CA hit a 30 year high in new STI transmissions
- Congenital syphilis cases are skyrocketing among low-income black and brown communities leading to many preventable stillbirths

OVERDOSE

- Fatal overdoses are skyrocketing across the state

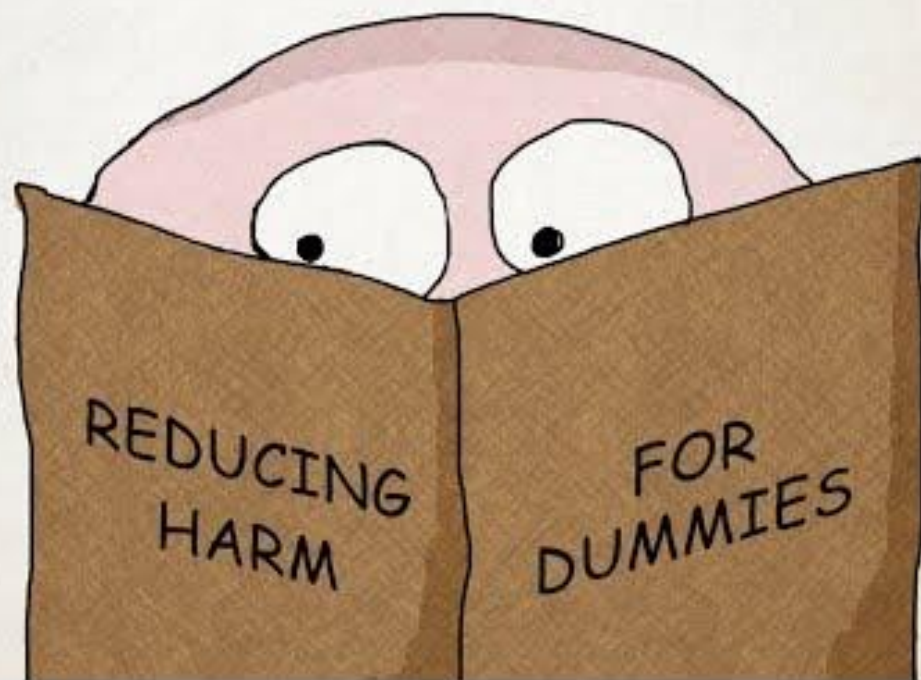

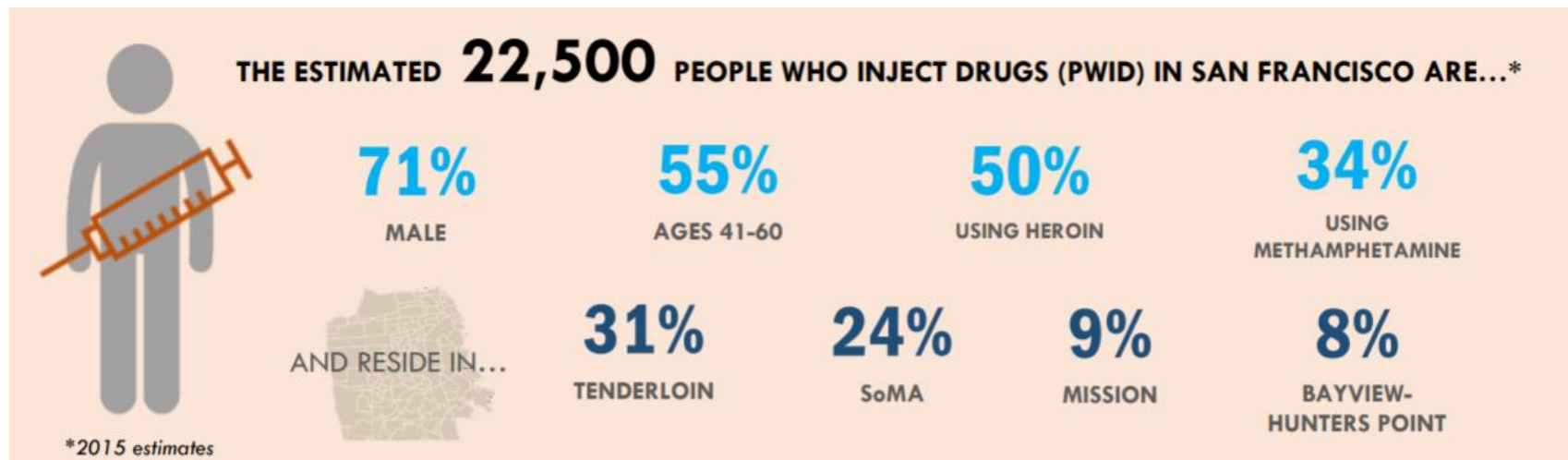

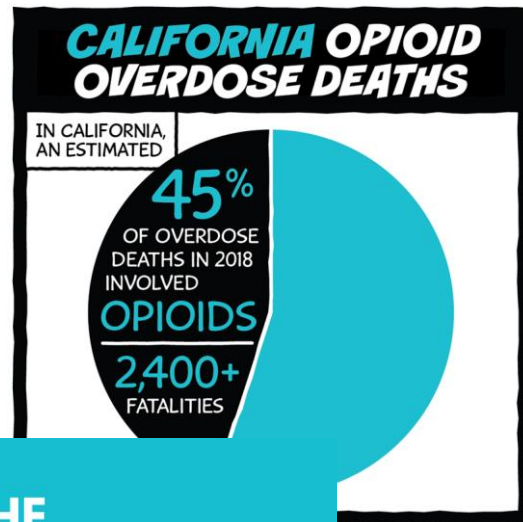


OVERDOSE EPIDEMIC

- Over 300 fatal overdoses in San Francisco in 2018 (increase for a third year in a row)
- PWID are at a higher risk for communicable diseases like HIV & HCV.

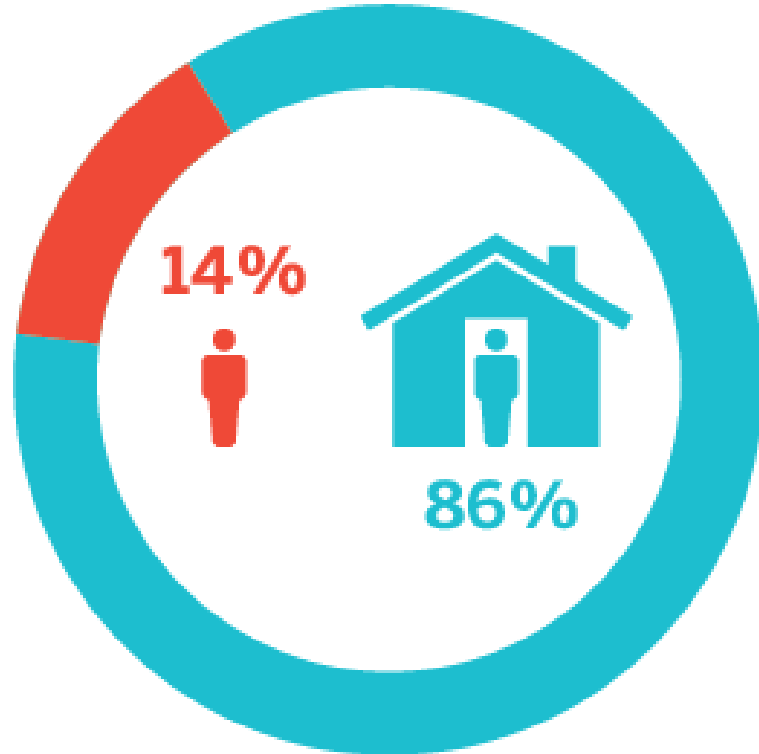

(2018 SF HIV Epi Report)

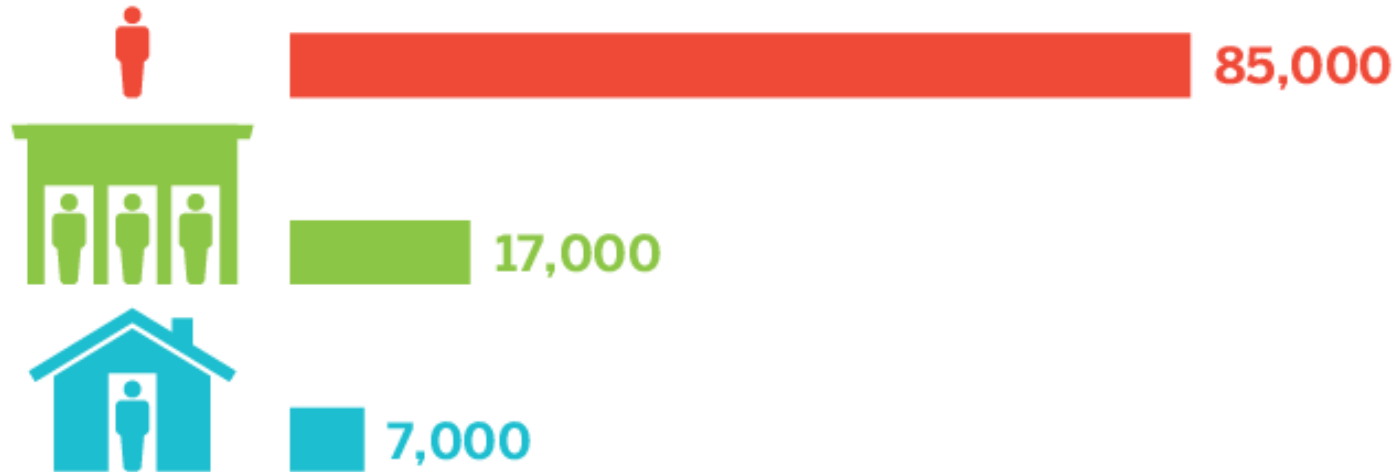
Less than a 1/3 of PLHIV

PERCENTAGE OF HIV+ PEOPLE WHO ARE VIRALLY SUPPRESSED



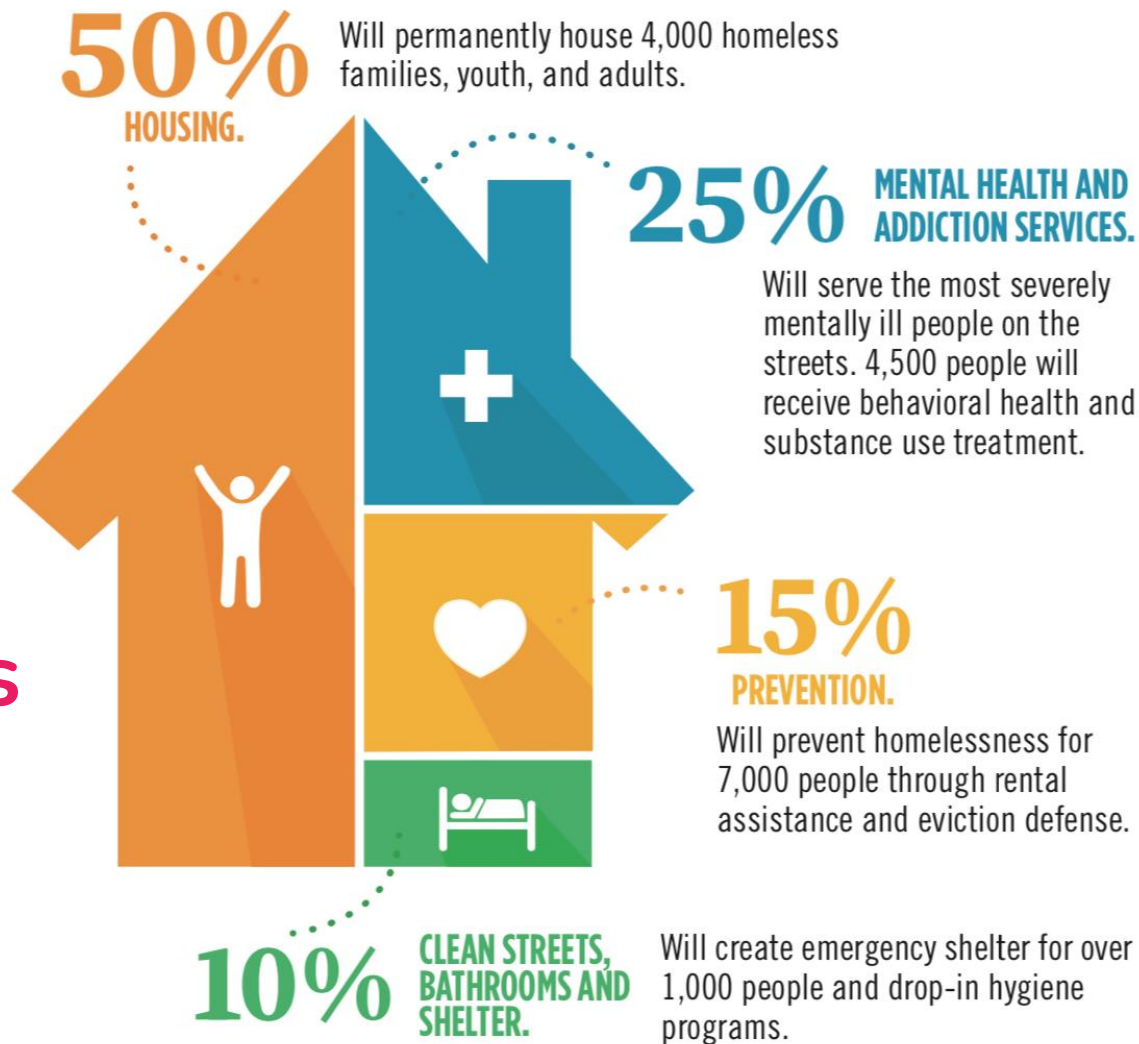
When people have housing their viral load drops (2017 SF HIV Epi Report)


