Equality Act: 2021

- >Passed House 02/25/2021
- This bill prohibits discrimination based on sex, sexual orientation, and **gender identity** in areas including public accommodations and facilities, education, federal funding, employment, housing, credit, and the jury system.
- >The bill allows the Department of Justice to intervene in equal protection actions in federal court on account of sexual orientation or gender identity.
- The bill prohibits an individual from being denied access to a shared facility, including a restroom, a locker room, and a dressing room, that is in accordance with the individual's gender identity.

San Francisco Policy

➤SEC. 3301. POLICY. It is the policy of the City and County of San Francisco to eliminate discrimination based on race, color, ancestry, national origin, place of birth, sex, age, religion, creed, disability, sexual orientation, gender identity, weight or height within the City and County.

 In such areas as employment, housing, long-term care facilities, businesses, public accommodations, and all-gender toilet facilities.

Human Rights Commission

"The Human Rights Commission of SF emphasizes that... an individual determines their own gender identity and the sole proof of a person's gender identity is that person's statement or expression of their self identification... refusing to treat transgender or gender-variant people in the same manner as other people is a violation of San Francisco laws. The Human Rights Commission is charged with investigating complaints of discrimination based on gender identity.

Names & Pronouns

- Names are Important.
 - Given/Legal or "Dead name" vs. "Preferred" name

- Getting comfortable with Pronouns:
 - He/Him/His Example: "He is here for his appointment."
 - She/Her/Hers Example: "She is here for her appointment."
 - They/Them/Theirs

Example: "They are here for their appointment."

Sex Assigned at Birth

People are assigned one of two sexes at birth (or shortly after birth).

- 1. Male
- 2. Female



Gender Identity & Gender Expression

Gender Identity

 Is how a person feels inside, or our internal sense of gender.

Gender Expression

 Is how a person expresses their gender externally, what people see. For example: dress, hair style, gestures, behaviors, etc.




Transgender

An umbrella term used to describe an individuals' **gender identity** that differs from the sex they were assigned at birth.

Transgender is an adjective, not a verb or noun.

- <u>Correct usage</u>: "...Transgender people." "I have a client who is transgender." "My client is a transgender woman"
- <u>Incorrect & offensive</u>: "A group of transgenders" "That person is a male transgender" "She is transgendered" "The patient will trans from female to male"

Sexual Orientation


Includes:

- Romantic
- Emotional
- Sexual attraction



What we refer to as Heterosexual/Straight and the LGBQ, notice no T, as sexual orientation does not include gender identity or gender expression.

The Assumption: The Social Construction of Sex and Gender is...

Assigned male at birth

intersex = a combination of the two.

Gender identity is how you, in your head, think about yourself. It's the chemistry that composes you (e.g., hormonal levels) and how you interpret what that means.

Feminine Expression of Gender



Gender expression is how you demonstrate your gender (based on traditional gender roles) through the ways you act, dress, behave, and interact.


Heterosexual Identified



Sexual orientation is who you are physically, spiritually, and emotionally attracted to, based on their sex/gender in relation to your own.
