The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has confirmed 9,677,827 cases of COVID-19 (novel coronavirus-2019) and 92,185 deaths in California. More information can be found at: www.covid19.ca.gov

As of July 19, 2022, SFDPH is reporting 164,437 cases of COVID-19 in San Francisco, with 928 deaths.

 - As of June July 18th19, 11th, the number of COVID-19 hospitalizations in San Francisco was 14581, up from 79-81 last month.
 - As of June 22July 21st, the percentage of San Francisco residents that have completed the vaccination series is 84%, same as the previous month.

 and medical case management programs to address Viral Suppression Rate equity for the Black/African
 American population and for People Experiencing Homelessness and Housing Instability

HHS Staffing

- HHS has submitted a request to hire to the -Ending The HIV Epidemic Coordinator Position.
- Acting Director Position has posted for internal reassignment.
- HHS will have a San Francisco Fellow early career analyst joining the team from September 12th through the following August working with the team on both HHS quality improvement projects and Health Care for the Homeless quality improvement and patient and community input work
- Requests to refill Kevin and Joseph's roles have been submitted to HR.
- Blum Director of HHS will represent HIV Health Services at future HCPC meetings.
