HIV Community Budget Proposal

Fight to maintain & strengthen the SF HIV safety net and address the housing, mental health and overdose crises affecting HIV communities.

Preserve the HIV Care Safety Net (TBD)

We must replace any loss of federal HIV funding with local funding to ensure people living with HIV have access to adequate care and services. CODB Increase for HIV Contracts (\$500k)

Provide a small cost-of-doing -business and cost-of-living adjustment to HIV organizations to ensure they're able to maintain crucial services that our communities rely on.

Maintain the HIV Prevention Safety Net (\$2-3 million)

Ensure that existing HIV prevention services are fully funded while increasing resources to address disparities. HIV Housing Subsidies (\$3 million)

Provide 300 additional housing subsidies for people living with HIV.

Mental Health for Long Term Survivors (\$1 million)

Fund additional mental health services and coordination for people aging with HIV.

Intensive HIV Case Management Services (\$1 million)

Fund intensive case management services for vulnerable members of our community facing acute behavioral health needs who too often lack access to social, mental and health services. Safer Consumption Sites (\$2 million)

Open and fund the implementation of an overdose prevention site (aka safer consumption site) in San Francisco to prevent fatal overdoses.
