#### Administrative and Program Updates

CHEP developed and allocated funding for Request for Proposals (RFP) 4-2019: An equity focused, community centered, whole-person care approach to Integrated HIV, HCV, and STI Prevention Programs for affected communities (also known as the Health Access Point (HAP) RFP). All HAP contractors start 1/1/2023.

#### Goal and focus of RFP 4-2019:

- To ensure that all San Franciscans have equitable access to high quality prevention, care, and treatment services to attain
  optimal health regarding HIV, STI, and HCV wellness
- This RFP focused on reaching equity by addressing the disparities that result in disproportionate levels of HIV, HCV, and STI.
- HAP model is outcome of multi-year community engagement process and implements community and stakeholder recommendations—a centralized and integrated whole person care approach, and to intentionally direct funding to support communities most disproportionately affected by HIV, HCV, and STIs
