HIV Community Planning Council Meeting on October 24, 2022

#### Administrative and Program Updates

- Health Officer Dr. Susan Philip announced DPH plans on letting the local emergency declaration for MPX expire October 31
  - o MPX cases continue to decline and demand for MPX vaccine has decreased
  - o MPX vaccine efforts proved to be successful in getting vulnerable populations protected
  - DPH will continue MPX prevention efforts, with special focus on encouraging those eligible to receive their 2<sup>nd</sup> dose
- SF MPX Newsletter will transition to publishing biweekly
