HHS Administrative Updates

- HIV State/ Federal Funding Updates
 - HHS received full RWPA FY 23/24 award notification in the amount of \$14,435,497
 - This represents a \$16,588 (0.12%) reduction from RWPA FY22/34 of \$14,418,909.
 - HHS can absorb this \$16,588 reduction in the grant administration budget leaving programs with level funding for current FY23/24
 - Recap of other federal HIV FY 22/23 FY funding
 - HRSA/HAB RWPC FY23/24 informed SF DPH that the award amount for San Francisco is \$293,137.
 - This is level funding from previous year.
 - HRSA/HAB informed that the SF EHE FY 23/24 award is \$2,555,761.
 - This is an increase of \$555,361 from \$2,000,400 in FY 22/23.
- Grant Reporting
 - HHS submitted funding plan for EHE among Community Provider Agencies, UCSF and SF
 DPH for programs serving populations identified with health outcome disparities.
 - new program services funded with additional funding:
 - linkage and maintenance in care services
 - housing focused case management
 - intensive case management focused on homeless populations
 - Cost of Doing Business (CODB) adjustments for community based organizations (CBO)
- Federal Program Monitoring Site Visits
 - HRSA/HAB EHE Site Visit scheduled for July 25-28, 20023 by HRSA/HAB.
 - HRSA/HAB Ryan White Part A Site Visit tentatively scheduled for August 2023.
- Consultant Robert Whirry continues to conduct a Landscape Analysis of San Francisco HIV Mental Health Services with a focus on long term survivors
