## HIV Health Services (HHS) Updates for January 23, 2023 HIV Community Planning Council Meeting

## **HHS Administrative Updates**

- HRSA/HAB provided a **partial RWPA FY2023/24 Notification of funding** in which approximately 26% Formula and 16% MAI) is released.
  - While HHS is not yet in receipt of the complete year when annualizing the partial award funding amount, it appears that there will be an 1.8% increase in RWPA formula and close to 2% increase in RWPA MAI.
  - o RWPA Supplemental Funding level is still pending.
- HHS submitted 2023/24 Non-Competing Continuation (NCC) RWPA grant due 12/22.
- Four mental health service providers are augmenting mental health services for long term survivors with the \$200,000 additional General Fund funding recently allocated by the BOS and Mayor.
  - HHS has secured services of Robert Whirry who has been a comprehensive mental health needs assessment which will be conducted over the next three to five months.
- HHS is redesigning our website.
  - HHS is working with contracted vendor to modernize HHS website.
    - A consumer group including HCPC members will provide feedback during the redesign process

## **HHS CQI Trainings**

- The first session of a two-part **training on motivational interviewing with Steve Berg-Smith** was held on 01/20/23 with the second part scheduled 01/27/23.
  - Over thirty HIV providers attended the training.
  - RWPA Program Officer has clarified that only a narrow and specific range of trainings can qualify for RWPA CQI funding.
    - HHS is exploring other ways to fund quality insurance programs including but not limited to avoiding burn out, motivational interviewing, setting and maintaining boundaries, providing transgender competent services and others.

## **HHS Staffing Update**

- ADAP Coordinator Position (CCSF job class 2591) hiring has concluded, and a candidate is being referred to HR.
  - Thank you to Mark Molnar for serving on the interview panel.
- Health Program Coordinator (CCSF job class 2593) is likely to post in early spring.
