Administrative & Program Updates

- <u>Health Advisory: Penicillin G Benzathine (Bicillin L-A)</u> was issued by SFDPH to provide SF clinicians situational update on Bicillin L-A shortage as reported to the CDC.

- CHEP staff are continuing work with HAPs (Health Access Points) to support testing, protocol development and data collection.
- The HIV/HCV Policies and Operations Manual for CBOs is under revision and protocols for STI Testing is being added. The revised manual is expected to be completed for distribution by June 23rd, 2023.
- CHEP staff Thomas Knoble (Ending The Epidemics Manager) and Nova Cabugao (Capacity Building Liaison) plan to attend NASTAD's 2023 National Cluster and Outbreak Detection and Response Implementation Learning Collaborative (CDR ILC) Summit. Thomas plans to share updates from the CDR ILC in the next HCPC meeting.

Organized Events & Learning Opportunities

- <u>STI/HIV/HCV Skills Certification Training</u> is scheduled for May 22nd- May 26th and June 26th June 30th.
 - Due to a high demand from the community, the group added an additional training in June. Both trainings are fully booked at this time.
 - Trainees will gain knowledge in the following areas:
 - Health information to support clients in making informed choices regarding their STI/HIV/HCV concerns
 - Basic counselling skills to assist clients
 - Technical skills to prepare and collect blood through fingerstick
 - Interpret results for specific Hep-C and HIV rapid tests
