### **HIV Community Budget Proposal**









\$500 K	SUPPORT CRITICAL HIV SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS Fund a small cost-of-doing business and cost-of-living adjustment to HIV organizations to ensure they're able to maintain crucial services the community relies on.
\$3.6 MILLION	HIV HOUSING SUBSIDIES Provide 200 additional housing subsidies for people living with HIV.
\$500 K	MENTAL HEALTH FOR LONG TERM SURVIVORS Fund additional mental health services and coordination for people aging with HIV.
\$500 K	INTENSIVE CASE MANAGEMENT Fund intensive case management services for vulnerable members of our community facing behavioral health need.
\$1 - 2 MILLION	SAFER CONSUMPTION SITES Open and fund Safer Consumption Sites in SF to prevent fatal overdoses.

# Preserve the HIV Care Safety Net (NOT CUTS)

# HIV Housing Subsidies (\$3.6 million)

Provide 300 additional housing subsidies for people living with HIV.

# Mental Health for Long Term Survivors (\$500 k)

Fund additional mental health services and coordination for people aging with HIV.

## Intensive HIV Case Management Services (\$500 k)

Lance Toma

Fund intensive case management services for vulnerable members of our community facing acute behavioral health needs who too often lack access to social, mental and health services.

## Safer Consumption Sites (\$1 - 2 million)

Lance Toma

Open and fund the implementation of a safer consumption site (aka overdose prevention site) in San Francisco to prevent fatal overdoses.


