HIV Community Planning Council Meeting

HHS Administrative Updates

- **HIV State/ Federal Funding Updates**
 - All FY Ryan White and HIV/AIDS Bureau Ending the HIV Epidemic (HAB EHE) grant award totals received for FY23-24.

- **Grant Reporting**
 - HHS submitted funding plan for EHE among Community Provider Agencies, UCSF and SF DPH for programs serving populations identified with health outcomes pending HRSA/HAB approval late summer.

- **Federal Program Monitoring Site Visits**
 - HRSA/HAB EHE Site Visit scheduled for July 2023 by HRSA/HAB.
 - HRSA/HAB Ryan White Part A Site Visit tentatively scheduled for August 2023.

- **Consultant Robert Whirry** continues to conduct a **Landscape Analysis of San Francisco HIV Mental Health Services** with a focus on long term survivors
 - Scheduling multiple client focus groups with assistance of two HIV mental service community providers.
 - Key information interviews continue to be held.

- **Review and Update of Contract providers performance objectives for FY2023/24 and 24/25**

- **HHS Provider Trainings Development Activities**
 - Funding for activities moved from RWPA grant administration to SF GF in March 2023
 - Assessment of training, gaps and needs in existing system of care.
 - Opportunities for partnership
 - Identification of additional training resources in community.

HHS Staffing Update

- Health Program Coordinator III (CCSF job class 2593) – applications for job class closed. List projected to be adopted in late summer 2023.

- Health Care for the Homeless Director Position (CCSF job class 1823) – request to share eligible list made to another City Department.

- Health Program Coordinator II (CCSF job Class 2591) - applications for job class closed. List projected to be adopted in late summer 2023.
 - HPCII overseeing ARIES/ HIV Care Connect anticipated to post in next two to three months.
 - Request to hire for temporary fill of position submitted to DPH Human Resources (HR)
 - Permanent position pending Mayoral approval in late summer 2023.
