- CHEP is working with our HAPs to build out and improve their ability to conduct rapid syphilis testing at their sites and in community outreach settings.
- CHEP is collaborating with UCSF and the Latino Task Force to implement innovative ways to expand STI
 testing in the Latinx community, with particular emphasis on the immigrant community, MSM and people
 not engaged in routine medical care with take-home testing kits for gonorrhea and chlamydia provided at
 health fairs and a fixed health hub.

- The International Network on Health and Hepatitis in Substance Users (INHSU), with support from CHEP and End Hep C SF, is hosting a <u>Hepatitis C Intervention Symposium</u> on Nov 2nd from 9:30am-3:00pm. This free, inperson event will bring together frontline workers, program coordinators, clinicians, and peer workers to highlight hepatitis C (HCV) elimination interventions and discuss strategies for improving outcomes in the context of San Francisco's unique priorities and environment. It is intended to support anyone working with people who use drugs (program managers, doctors, nurses, frontline workers, peer workers, pharmacists, and policymakers) with implementing or scaling up interventions for HCV in their service setting.
