## **SF DPH Staffing Updates**

Maria Lacayo has promoted to a **Program Manager** (Health Program Coordinator III) with the **SF DPH Contract Development and Technical Assistance (CDTA) Unit** effective 12/6/24.

Aman Lail will become the Administrative Officer for Ambulatory Services for San Francisco Health Network replacing Dr Albert Yu, Director of Ambulatory Care, effective December 6, 2024.

**Tangerine Brigham** will become the **Deputy Director of San Francisco Health Network** replacing **Baljeet Singha** effective December 6, 2024.

## **HHS Administrative Updates**

HHS received HRSA/HAB RWPA Site Visit Report held 8/6/24 – 8/9/24.

- Overall report was positive with 13 commendations.
- HHS is developing a response for HRSA/HAB for submission 12/06/24.
- Compliance findings related to planning council:
  - Requirement to align services with service category definition. The recipient does not consistently align services with the service category: Specifically, the recipient identified Centers of Excellence and Money Management as service categories.
  - Requirement for PC membership to comply with representation and reflectiveness. San Francisco EMA HIV Community Planning Council currently has four vacancies in its legislatively mandated categories: State Medicaid, Part B agency, Part C provider, and Part D provider.
  - **o Consumer/stakeholder recruitment and/or involvement in RWHAP.**
  - Documentation that all PC members are duly appointed by the CEO.
  - Prioritization and allocation of funds requirements for activities in Marin and San Mateo Counties.
  - Requirement for prioritization and allocation of <u>all</u> Part A service categories (<u>including those</u> <u>not funded</u>).
  - Need for a separate process to allocate MAI funds.

- Documentation that all PC members completed with the COI (Conflict of Interest) form.
- Requirement for PC leadership to participate in the negotiation, development, and management of PC's support budget.
- Need to approve **Center of Excellence as a service model rather than service category**
- Need to establish **PC membership term limits and membership role rotation**.
- Need to **review HIV Community Planning Council's Bylaws** to ensure they include all information that is necessary for the PC to successfully carry out its legislative responsibilities.

HIV and Aging -City and County of San Francisco (CCSF) Cross Agency Collaboration

**SF Interagency Collaboration on HIV and Aging Work Group** consisting of HHS, Mayors Office of Housing and Community Development (MOHCD) and Disability and Aging Services (DAS) Office of Community Partnerships continues to meet monthly to identify and implement **opportunities for collaboration across programs to better serve HIV+ Elders and HIV+ People with Disabilities.** 

- o Cross Training line staff training among CCSF Departments
  - HHS held training for two sections of DAS staff and contract agencies on HIV system of care on November 19, 2024.
  - DAS: Office of Community Partnerships Director Michael Zaugg and LGBT Liaison, Maceo Persson presenting to HCPC at 11/25/24 meeting on Aging, HIV and LGBTQI services including HIV services.

HHS CQI and Service Improvement Work

HHS is working with SF DPH Jail Service (JHS) HIV Integrated Services (HIVIS) with EHE funded technical assistance provided by Cai on a project to ensure relinkage to care for people transitioning out of jail to the community.

• Current activities include **staff strategic planning retreat** as well as development of a **Power BI dashboard** with the goal to optimize client retention in care.

HHS with assistance from Facente Consulting with EHE funding has also begun a project to identify ways to leverage emergency short term hotel based funded through HIV emergency grants to create pathways to longer term stable housing.
