# HIV Services (HHS) Director's Report HIV Community Planning Council Meeting May 20, 2024



## **HHS Administrative Updates**

- Funding
  - HHS received a Notification of Award for EHE in the amount of \$2,559,219 for FY24/25.
    - This is a \$3,458 increase from the FY34/34 which was \$2,555,761.
  - HHS is pending notification of complete funding for RWPA and RWPC for FY24/25:
    - HHS will likely receive RWPA notification in the next two weeks.
    - HHS will likely receive RWPC notification in early to mid-June.
- HRSA/HAB Site Visit
  - RWPA site visit is scheduled for and confirmed for 8/6/24 8/9/24.
  - HRSA-HAB is planning to meet with HCPC leadership during their site visit.
- CA State Office of AIDS HIV Care Connect (HCC)
  - The ARIES successor system HCC go-live scheduled for 05/06/24 has been postponed.
    - SOA has not officially given a new date but they have indicated that the new target go-live date will be in approximately 2-3 months
    - HHS and contract agencies will continue to use ARIES in the interim.
    - HHS does not expect any negative effects for agencies or clients.
- Updating HHS Standards of Care (SOC) for SF Ryan White Funding
  - Standards of Care jointly developed and reviewed by the recipient (HHS) and the local planning body (HCPC) are a legislative requirement of Ryan White Programs for each EMA funded service category to ensure good standards and service are clearly defined.
  - Consultant Robert Whirry has reviewed existing national state and jurisdictional standards as well as engaged subject matter experts to edit or create SOC for SF EMA for review and approval by HCPC Steering and then full HCPC.
    - Goal is to complete review of all SOC by 06/24/24 HCPC Meeting.
    - In April 2024, four new standards of care were submitted to the Planning Council Steering Committee and approved by the full Planning Council, for Benefits Counseling, Home and Community-Based Care, Money Management, and Centers of Excellence.
    - In May 2024, a new standard of care for Food Services will be reviewed by the Planning Council Steering Committee for approval by the Planning Council.

- In June 2024, a total of seven new standards are expected to be presented to the Planning Council, for Mental Health, Primary Medical Care, Hospice Care, Therapeutic Monitoring, Legal Services, Psychosocial Support, and Outreach Services.
- In July 2024, six new standards of care are expected to be presented to the Planning Council, for Emergency Financial Assistance, Employment Services, Medical and Non-Medical Case Management, Housing and Residential Mental Health, Dental Services, and Overarching Standards of Care that apply to all programs.

#### **DPH Budget Reduction**

- Ambulatory Care Executive Leadership recently informed section leads that we will need to identify an additional 5% contingency reduction.
  - No updates.

#### SFDPH CHEP and HHS Plan for Integrated Plan and Blueprint Development and Implementation

- Facente Consulting met with SF DPH on 5/16/24 to transition blueprint implementation, tracking and reporting to SF DPH.
  - o Final DPH internal review of Blue-Print Document will be completed in May.
  - Began Developing tracking sheet for implementation.
- HIV and Aging -City and County of San Francisco (CCSF) Cross Agency Collaboration
- HHS, Mayors Office of Housing and Community Development (MOHCD) and Disability and Aging Services (DAS) Office of Community Partnerships held a second meeting on 5/20/24 to continue to explore opportunities for collaboration across programs to better serve HIV+ Elders and HIV+ People with Disabilities.
  - Cross Trainings of case managers in HIV and Disability and Aging services.
  - Michael Zaugg will serve as interim DAS point person for HIV needs and services.
  - o **DAS orienting to HIV working groups including HCPC** and will attend upcoming meeting.
  - o Create mutual links on DAS and HHS website.
  - On-going monthly meetings for next three months.
