- SFDPH celebrated the opening of the newly renovated Adult Immunization & Travel Clinic (AITC) at 27 Van Ness Avenue.
 - The SFDPH AITC is a fee-for-service clinic specializing in travel health and CDC-recommended vaccines for teens, adults, travelers, and immigrants. Services are by appointment only, and payment is required at the time of service; low-cost vaccines may be available for eligible patients.
 - JYNNEOS, the MPOX vaccine, is available at AITC. No-cost doses are available if you're medically eligible and uninsured or underinsured. Visit SF.gov/DPH to learn more.
