


% OF CLIENTS OVER 65 YEARS OF AGE




Client Housing Status




% OF CLIENTS TEMP / UNSTABLE HOUSING






% IDENTIFY AS A PERSON OF COLOR



Comprehensive assessment, evaluation, diagnosis, and treatment provided by a physician, physician assistant, registered nurse, and/or nurse practitioner in an outpatient setting. Services include diagnostic testing, early intervention and risk assessment, preventive care and screening, examination, diagnosis and treatment of common physical and mental health conditions, prescribing and managing medication therapy, education and counseling on health issues, continuing care, nutritional counseling and management of chronic conditions, and/or referral to and provision of all medical subspecialties.









Mental Health Services


Mental Health Services are the provision of outpatient psychological and psychiatric screening, assessment, diagnosis, treatment, and counseling services offered to clients living with HIV. Services are based on a treatment plan, conducted in an outpatient group or individual session, and provided by a mental health professional licensed or authorized within the state to render such services. Such professionals typically include psychiatrists, psychologists, and licensed clinical social workers.





Medical Case Management

Medical case management services are a range of client-centered services that link clients with health care, psychosocial and other services; the coordination and follow-up of medical treatments are key components of medical case management.

Two programs targeting HIV+ Asian Pacific Islander individuals and multiply diagnosed COE clients, with concurrent substance abuse and/or mental health problems; who live in the Tenderloin

Program targeting HIV positive residents in San Francisco who are uninsured, underinsured, or have severe needs; services include case management and peer advocacy.

Program targeting HIV positive residents in San Francisco who are longterm survivors of HIV.




Home Health Care include skilled health services provided in the individual's home based on a written plan of care established by a case management team that includes appropriate health care professionals. Services include durable medical equipment; home health aide services and personal care services in the home; day treatment or other partial hospitalization services; home intravenous and aerosolized drug therapy (including prescription drugs administered as part of such therapy); routine diagnostics testing administered in the home; and appropriate mental health, developmental, and rehabilitation services

SAN Attendant care at residential hotels to maintain the independence of clients living in single room occupancy **FRANCISCO** (SRO) to prevent or avoid institutional care. In-home respite and attendant care to relieve caregivers and provide limited attendant care to those needing periodic support. Induction and maintenance infusion therapy services to homebound individuals, including patient training on self-administration. Services provided in the homes of clients throughout the city. Program provides a system of assessment, planning, service procurement, delivery, coordination, and disease monitoring to people with disabling HIV/AIDS. Home Care Attendants assist clients in the maintenance of their home life in collaboration with Nurse Case Managers and Social Workers to ensure clients can remain in their homes while receiving coordinated care from medical and case management providers.












Hospice Services



The services ensure that people with HIV-related illnesses obtain the medical, psychosocial, and home care services they need to sustain them in the community through their illness, thereby avoiding costly institutionalization.
























Food Bank / Delivered Meals


Services provided includes prepared meals, groceries, and nutrition education under the supervision of a Registered Dietitian; food solicitation and a food bank for agencies that feed their HIV clients. Services include congregate meals and nutritional counseling. A weekly selection of groceries that meets one-third of the weekly nutritional requirements for persons living with HIV; or various grocery items solicited through the food bank and distributed by HIV service agencies. Hot or frozen prepared meals that meet one-third of the daily nutritional requirements for persons living with HIV. Clients can choose hot or frozen meals, home-delivered or picked-up, daily or







Services provided for the treatment of drug or alcohol use disorders in a residential setting to include screening, assessment, diagnosis, and treatment of substance use disorder. Activities provided under the Substance Abuse Services (residential) service category include Pretreatment/recovery readiness programs; Harm reduction; Behavioral health counseling associated with substance use disorder; Medication assisted therapy; Neuro-psychiatric pharmaceuticals; Relapse prevention; Detoxification, if offered in a separate licensed residential setting (including a separately-licensed detoxification facility within the walls of an inpatient medical or psychiatric hospital)









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
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








Non-Medical Case Management Services (NMCM) is the provision of a range of client-centered activities focused on improving access to and retention in needed core medical and support services. NMCM provides coordination, guidance, and assistance in accessing medical, social, community, legal, financial, employment, vocational, and/or other needed services. NMCM Services includes all types of case management encounters (e.g., face-to-face, telehealth, phone contact, and any other forms of communication).








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




Outreach Services


