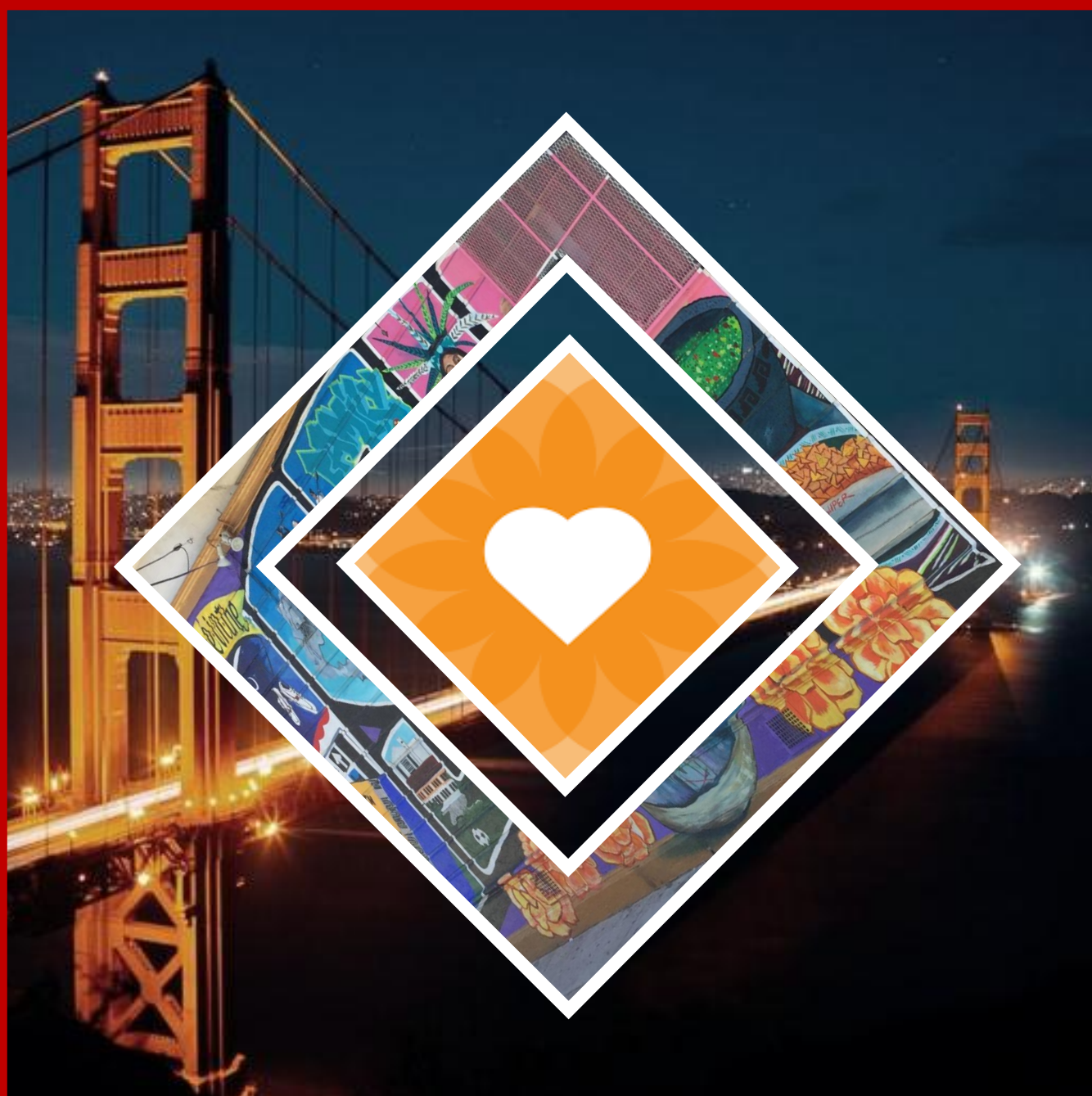




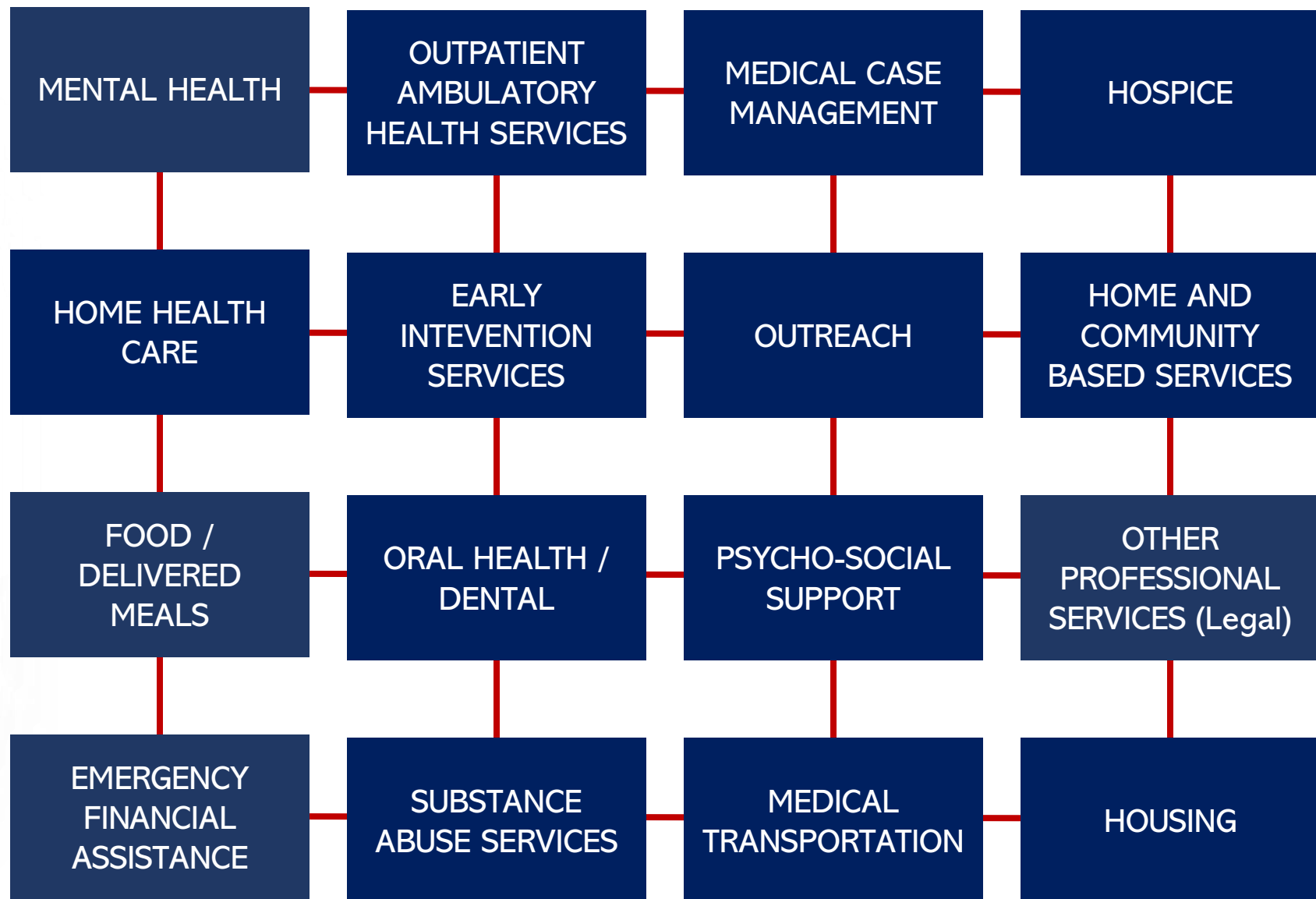

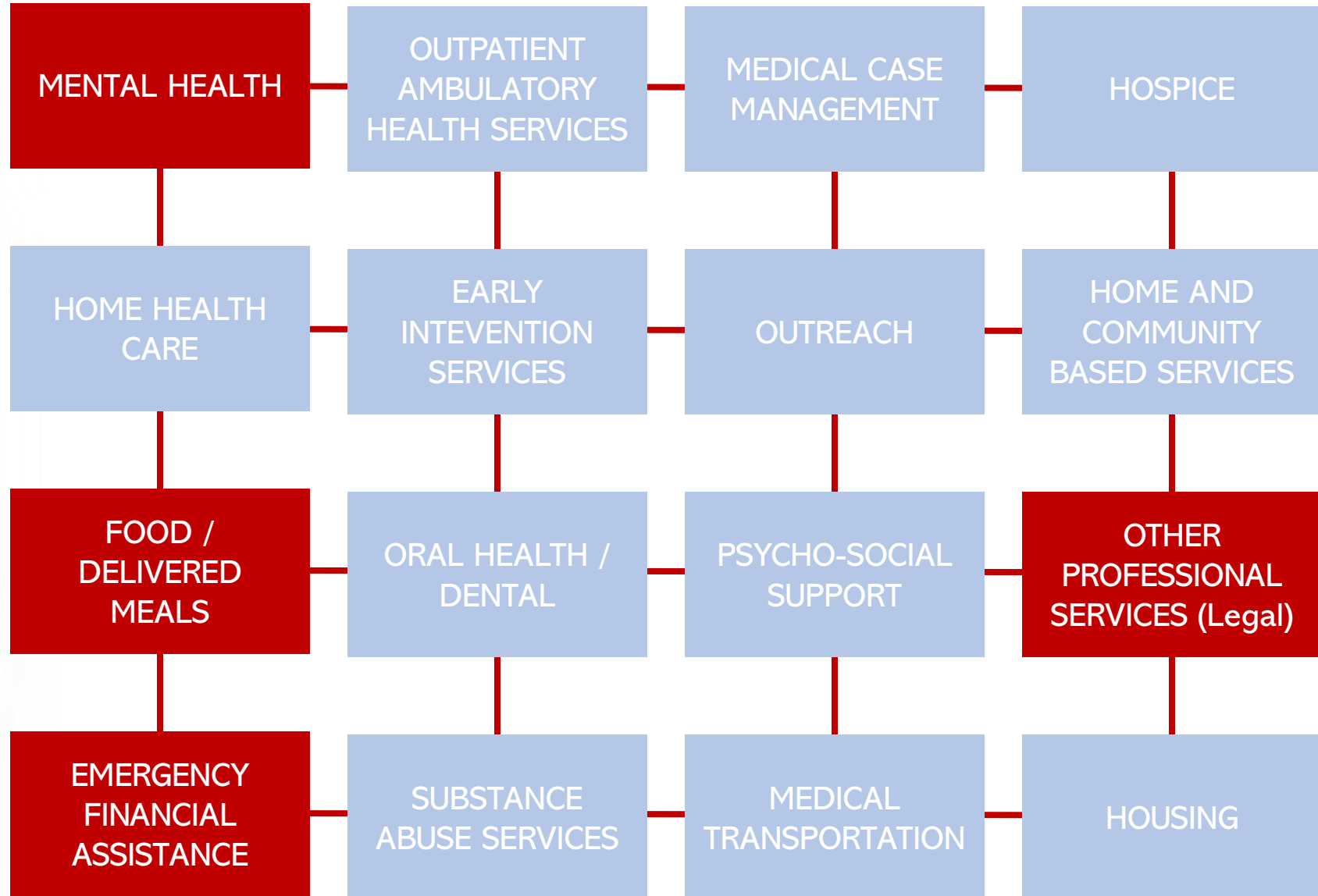

1. Emergency Financial Assistance \$ 120,000

Many RWPA eligible clients are requesting emergency financial assistance in meeting the most basic of living expenses, which has been increased this year and last due to the impact of the COVID pandemic on the economy. These funds are also utilized as eviction prevention funds to assist clients from losing housing and potentially becoming homeless. Clients are capped at \$500 annually for Emergency Financial Assistance grants. The addition of carry forward dollars to this program represents no additional administrative programmatic expenses and directly expands the number of financial assistance grants available for clients.

Units of service: \$120,000 provided in \$700 increments to 154 clients

2. Food Bank/Home Delivered Meals \$ 207,593 (MAI)

Provision of services includes prepared meals, groceries, and nutrition education under the supervision of a Registered Dietitian; also food solicitation and a food bank for agencies that feed their HIV clients. Services can include congregate meals and nutritional counseling. Services include:

- Food Pantry/Groceries
- Home-Delivered Meals

Units of service: 120 clients x 12 meals/month x \$15 meal x 5/months = \$107,593
167 clients x 4 bag/month x \$30 bag x 5/months = \$100,000

3. Mental Health – Trainings \$ 49,302

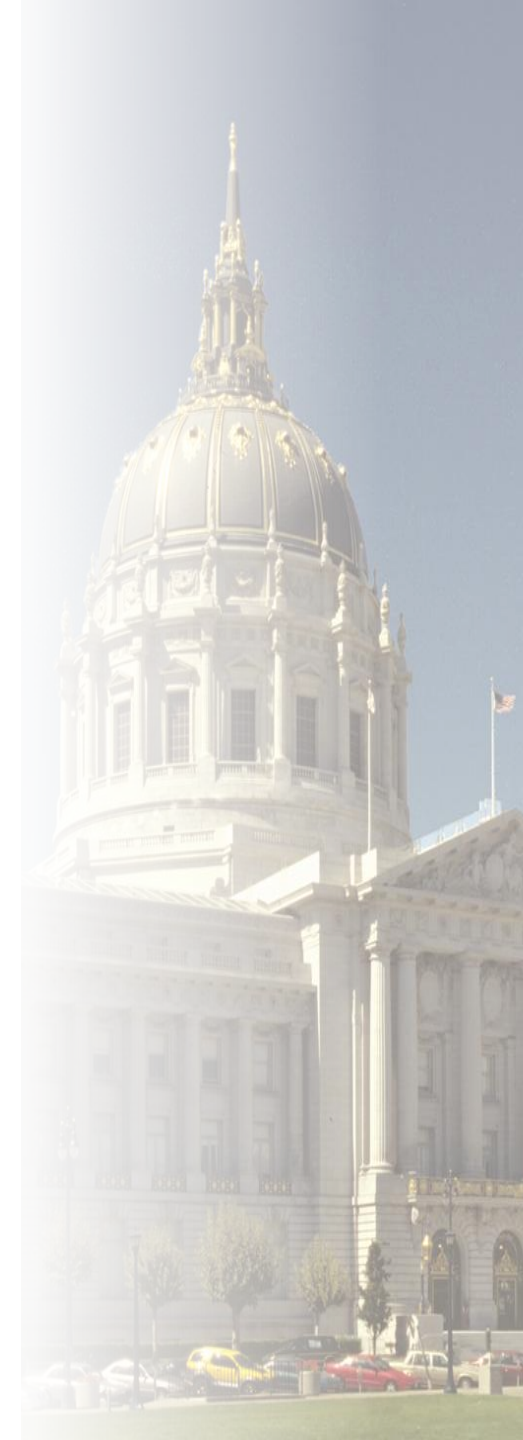
- Trauma Informed Care training that is especially focused on Long Term Survivors and Aging
 - Five trainings; recorded; available both in-person and remote
- Train the Trainers Curriculum for a Mutual Aid (Clients helping Clients) Living Healthfully Groups
 - Peer led groups such as Positive Force, Living Now, and Plus
 - Pilot training 1-2 times

Units of service: None

4. Other Professional - Legal Stipends \$ 20,000

Support for additional Legal Services Interns to support client case research and client interviews to better address emerging legal needs. This is proposed in part due to the on-going housing crisis in San Francisco and potential complications as we emerge from eviction moratoriums.
