Updates and Event Highlights

- On July 11, the Wellness Initiative for Sexual Health Equity and Safer Use (WISHES) partnered with the Department of Emergency Management at One City Day to provide Hands-Only CPR training and Naloxone training to San Francisco residents.
- **OnBoard SF: A Frontline Worker Summit 2026**
 - **Date:** August 11, 2026

 - **Location:** SF LGBT Center (2nd Floor).
 - OnBoard SF is a one-day immersive learning and networking event designed to support new and developing frontline workers in San Francisco's HIV, HCV, STI, sexual health, and drug user health systems.
- Beginning in July, HRTI (formerly the Harm Reduction Training Institute) is now the Health and Recovery Training Institute. HRTI provides support to SFDPH and funded partners and providers working with people who use drugs and their communities.
- The Have Good Sex campaign is an SFDPH-led initiative that promotes sexual positivity and inclusivity, with a particular focus on Black and Latine communities in San Francisco.
