HHS Administrative Updates

HHS is participating with SF DPH Business Office of Contract Compliance in the annual contract monitoring site visits to HHS funded agencies

- **HHS has 41 agencies with 85 programs in this cycle of which staff is planning to attend 71 (including 100% of federally funded programs)**
 - **The monitoring includes review of site facilities, review of contract objectives, contract deliverables, client satisfaction and grievance procedures, agency safety practices and personnel training files among others.**

HHS is currently completing two annual noncompetitive grant applications for RWPA due 10/01/26 and RWPC due on 12/18/26.

Attendance at Ryan White All Parts Conference

HRSA HAB held its biannual 2026 National Ryan White Conference on Care and Treatment from 08/02/26- 8 8/05

- **The conference consisted of 6 tracks including data utilization, Improving Access, Engagement/Reengagement and Health Outcomes, Clinical Quality Management, RWHAP Planning and Resource Allocation: Community Engagement and Collective Partnerships, RWHAP and EHE Fiscal and Grant Management and Strategies to identify and Reach People with HIV are Undiagnosed or Out of Care.**
- **To meet grantee requirements four HHS Staff attended this year's Ryan White All Parts Conference in person and an additional four attended parts of the conference virtually as well as the HPPC Council Support Director, one HCPC Council CO-Chair and one CAEAR Coalition Representative.**

HRSA HAB will hold its “Reverse Site Visit Meeting” next year

- **For the first time, plan is to include Planning Council Representation.**
